

Making a bank transfer to Grace Church Milton Keynes.

We bank with CAF Bank Ltd (part of the Charities Aid Foundation), which operates through HSBC. They offer special services for many charities like us.

Recently the main high street banks set up the **Confirmation of Payee** system to try and prevent transfers to fraudulent accounts. Sadly, our bank is not a party to this scheme.

Your bank or building society may therefore flag transfers to the Grace Church Milton Keynes bank account as a scam or fraud risk because it can't verify our details. It may even block them if you're transferring a large amount. It will usually allow you to go ahead if you so choose, though, after some scary warnings.

For peace of mind, you can begin by depositing a small amount, such as £1, and once you can see the transfer reflected in your account balance (normally within 2 hours for Faster Payments), you can transfer the rest of your donation amount, or set up a standing order, since most banks will ask if you are transferring funds to someone you have paid before, which should by-pass the warnings. You can then begin transferring your tithes and offerings to us as and when you wish.

Please only transfer funds to the Grace Church Milton Keynes Account sort code and account number as displayed on our web site "Giving" page (and below), entering your name as the reference. If you are a UK taxpayer, please consider gift-aiding your offerings as we gain an extra 25% at no cost to you!
